 - 3hr minimum charge 1800hrs-0700 hrs Mon-Fri, weekends & public holidays
- ◆ 1,000 GT to 29,999 GT \$ 0.523 / GT
- ◆ 30,000 GT to 59,999 GT \$ 0.414 / GT plus \$ 2,256
- ◆ 60,000 GT to 89,999 GT \$ 0.313 / GT plus \$ 5,025
- ◆ 90,000 GT + \$ 0.1 / GT plus \$ 25,124

Daily Service Charge

- ◆ ISPS code compliant vessel = \$ 0.205 / GT per 24 hours or part thereof (Includes security charge ***).
 - Minimum daily service charge \$ 2,194
 - Maximum daily service charge \$ 18,450
 - *** For Cruise Ships this charge covers security for up to 12hrs only.
- ◆ All other vessels > 1,000 GT: \$ 0.149 / GT per 24 hours or part thereof. Minimum charge \$ 910/day
- ◆ Public holiday surcharge 15%

Tendering (Anchorage)

- ◆ 50% of Port Access Charge per 24 hours or part thereof

Fishing Vessels < 30m

- ◆ Under 20 metres \$ 80 / 24hours or part thereof

Port Marlborough provides a reserved berth for cruise vessels to ensure they have a guaranteed berth access ahead of any other potential port user. In the event of any cruise vessel cancelling its Marlborough call within 72 hours of its ETA, the call will be billed at 50% of the Port Access charge
